406 Ranch Horse Challenge Rules:

1. All dogs must be on a leash at all times!
2. This is a Ranch Horse Show. Class Participation rules will be followed (AQHA SHW556). Excessive silver is discouraged, and silver will not count over a good working outfit. No hoof polish and no fake tails.
3. Cow classes must be entered by August 25th. No Late Entries Allowed into Cow Classes! Non-cow classes can be entered up to show day. Additional class entries will be accepted up to three classes prior to the class being entered provided the horse and rider are already registered with the show office.
4. ***IT IS UP TO THE EXHIBITOR TO KNOW ALL ELIGIBILITY RULES AND ENTER ACCORDINGLY.***
5. All Breed division will follow AQHA rules.
6. Any necessary gate holds for tack change or other reasons must be scheduled with the gate person at least 24 hours prior to the gate hold.
7. Any show changes will be posted in the show office.
8. There will be no abuse of any animal allowed during the show. Anyone abusing an animal will be asked to leave the show grounds, forfeit all fees, and be reported to law enforcement.
9. There is no haul-in fee, but stalls may only be used if paid for. If a horse is found in the campain, a \$50 fee will be assessed. **All stalls must be cleaned by exhibitor before leaving. 406 Vaulting Club offers youth pre-bed (\$5/stall) and cleaning (\$10/stall) after the show.** Don't forget to clean up around your trailer and stalling area!
10. Stalls and RV plugins have limited availability. Stalling requests will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Not all stalling requests can be accommodated. Please reserve early.
11. Entering an approved breed association class will require payment of additional fees.
 - a. AQHA requires a \$10 administration fee per horse, per judge per show. Due to the nature of the AQHA show setup a \$10 administration fee per horse, per judge will be due for entering each of the following class sets:
 - 1) AQHA VRH;
 - 2) AQHA Heading and Heeling;
 - 3) AQHA Cutting and Working Cow Horse;
 - 4) Non-VRH Ranch Riding, Open, All Ranch Trail, and Working Western Rail
 - b. MQHA collects a \$1 fee per AQHA class entry.
12. **YOUTH ALL INCLUSIVE FEE!** The Youth All Inclusive Fee is charged per horse and rider combination and applies to all youth divisions. If a youth would like to show two or more horses the All Inclusive fee is charged per horse. If a youth would like to show the same horse in more than one breed association, for example entering both the All Breed and their eligible breed association the All Inclusive fee is charged per breed division. Youth All Inclusive Fee only applies to youth classes. If a youth enters an open division class, they must pay the open division class, cow fees and any required breed association fees.
 - a. Youth All Inclusive Fee includes the following: Office Fee, Breed Association Fees, Cow Fees, and Class Entry Fees. **Stall fees, savings, and stall bedding or cleaning fees not included.**
 - b. Youth All Inclusive Fee for entering all classes = \$100 per horse and rider combination.
 - c. Youth All Inclusive Fee for entering only non-cow classes = \$60 per horse and rider combo.
13. **NEW IN 2025!!** Youth Montana State 4-H Working Ranch Horse Finals DISCOUNT. Each horse and rider combination entered in the Youth Montana State 4-H Working Ranch Horse Finals will receive a 50% discount off the All Inclusive Fee. Confirmation of entry must be received by September 4th.
14. Payment of show fees is due at time of check-in.
15. **SUSPENSES & REFUNDS: Cow Fees are NOT REFUNDABLE after August 25th.** No Exceptions. Other show fees will be refundable with a veterinarian or doctor letter submitted to the show secretary before the start of the show.
accounts must be approved and closed out by the exhibitor with the show secretary before leaving the show.
16. 406 Arena and/or any management, volunteers or others associated with the show will not be held responsible for any losses or damages to the exhibitor, owner, horse, or equipment while on the show grounds. To minimize the risk of theft please leave all vehicles and trailers locked.
18. Submitting entry form shall be deemed acceptance by all parties involved of these rules.
